## **Congratulations to Don Bitzer!**

Dr. Donald L. Bitzer, Distinguished University Research Professor of Computer Science, won an Emmy in 2002 for his efforts in advancing television technology. In 1964 he co-invented the flat plasma display panel for his students working long hours at their computers. Plasma screens, which do not flicker, are a significant advance in television technology.

A member of the National Academy of Engineering since 1974, Dr. Bitzer was designated a National Associate by the National Academies in 2002.
