

## Becoming a Tutor in the Engineering Tutorial Program

Thank you for your interest in being a part of the Engineering Tutorial Program! Tutoring can provide you with a great way to solidify your subject knowledge and develop your communication and leadership skills, as well as provide a helpful service to your fellow students.

To apply as a tutor, you must meet the following minimum requirements:

- Have at least a 3.0 overall and major GPA
- Have earned a B+ or better in the course you wish to tutor
- Be available to tutor at least one (preferably two) evenings per week for the full semester

Tutoring is a temporary, part-time position. Tutors are paid on a bi-weekly basis based on the hours worked during each period. The current pay rate for tutoring in this program starts at \$10/hour and can increase based on experience. Typical help session hours will be during the evening sometime between 6:00 p.m. and 9:30 p.m. for a 2-hour period. There will typically be two tutors staffed for each session. There may be multiple courses from the same department tutored at the same time, depending on the number of students expected.

If you are interested in applying for a tutoring position this semester, please fill out both the Engineering Tutor Application and the Temporary Employment Application, sign them and turn them into the Engineering Academic Affairs office in 120 Page Hall.
