Students can be dropped off from 8:30 a.m. – 9:00 a.m.

Students **MUST** be picked up by 3:45 p.m.

Camp Costs:

\$250 per student. A limited number of need-based partial scholarships may also be available.

Application Process:

1) **Complete the application packet.**

2) **Student completes a brief statement on why she/he would like to attend camp.**

The student statement is very important in the selection process, so the student should take his or her time composing this statement.

3) **If you are requesting to be considered for a need-based scholarship, obtain a letter of demonstrated financial need from the school district's Child Nutrition Department.**

Since we do not wish to receive personal financial information from families, we rely on the schools to indicate demonstrated need. Generally, participation in a free or reduced lunch program is an indicator, but other needs may be considered. *For home schooled students, parents should write the letter for the scholarship request indicating factors influencing financial need without providing specific financial information.*
