Based on the 2014 Comprehensive Articulation Agreement, students should pay close attention to specific University requirements since all NC State specific General Education requirements must be satisfied.

## Physical Education (2 courses)

Before graduating from NC State, the student must have PED 110, PED 115, PED 120,
PED 154, or PED 155 and any other activity based physical education course.

## Foreign Language Proficiency

Before graduating from NC State, the student must have proficiency at the FL* 102 level. This can be demonstrated by completing two years of high school study of the same language with a grade better than a C - in each of the two years, or a passing grade at the FL* 112 level (like SPA 111/112) , or by placement into the FL* 211 by examination.
